SUMMARY

GREENPORT seeks to initiate a change in the port services, by integrating sustainability coherently within new education solutions, thus teaching future and current port service personnel to become more sustainable in their attitudes and behaviours. This can only be made possible by the cooperation of both public and private, academia/research and industry operatives. The project has thus been designed in a logical and modular way, which at the same time is interconnected and feeds into each other so that each WP achieves outputs that open the door to further development and elaboration in the next WP, ultimately leading to the creation of the GREENPORT learning curricula as a framework that can eventually be replicated in many European Universities and education providers.

The project also intends to make use of EU instruments and tools whenever relevant. Namely:

- The developed Higher Education learning content will be integrated within existing programmes using the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS) for standardisation and transparency in the European Higher Education Area.
- The VET course content will also be evaluated and updated in accordance the European Quality Assurance Reference Framework for Vocational Education and Training (EQAVET), assuring the quality of the learning content, methodology design, awards and qualifications are in line with the principles of the EQAVET Framework.
- Micro-credential certification will also be accredited where appropriate for the Train-the-Trainers eLearning course piloted in WP5, to enhance the transparency of the knowledge, skills and competences participants can gain through these courses.
- The EntreComp Framework is integrated into the educational outputs that will be developed by the project, and will be directly
